

# Latest INF World Ranking: Matches up to 20 December 2014

The INF World Rankings have been updated to take into account the England/Wales/Malawi Test Series held in England, and the Nations Cup held in Singapore, both during December.

The Nations Cup saw Singapore, Republic of Ireland, Botswana, Samoa, Malaysia and Papua New Guinea battling it out for the trophy, with Singapore triumphant. England were victorious in their match against Wales and their two games played against Malawi. As a result of these matches there is no change to the top ten, however Samoa now moves up one position to 13, with Uganda dropping back to 14. Singapore now claims 17th spot, with Papua New Guinea back to 19th position. The Republic of Ireland moves back one place to 28, with Hong Kong now sitting at 27.
